Maths



Focus on your target times tables. By the end of Year 1, all children are expected to be able to count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10 and be able to recall all of the doubles and halves to 10.

Show at least <u>three</u> examples of where you have practised your times tables during the Autumn term.

Work on your fluency. How many words can you read in a minute? Expected for a Year 1/2 child is between words a minute.
