Maths



Focus on your target times tables. By the end of Years 5/6, all children are expected to know all of their multiplication and division facts up to and including their 12 times tables.

Remember to know them you need to be able to recall them instantly.

Show at least **three** examples of where you have practised your times tables during the Autumn term.

One piece of work will be set on My Maths every week.

English



Years 5 & 6 should read every day for 25-30 minutes. Remember to make a comment in your diary! These will be checked on a **daily** basis.

Work on your fluency. How many words can you read in a minute? Expected for a Year 5/6 child is between 160-200 words a minute.

Work on comprehension (PEE-Point, Evidence, Explanation)

One piece of work will be set on Spag.com every week.

Research 10 facts about the history of Australia.



Create a poster about the location of Australia. Remember to include information about the surrounding oceans, countries and mountains.



Art/Creative

Design and make a surfboard.



Create a 3D model of The Great Barrier Reef- be as creative as you can.



Record **three** examples of when you use Maths in everyday life. These can be recorded in different ways, for example, using photos or written sentences about how you used Maths.

Write a short story about an 'Awesome Adventure to Australia'. Where will you go? What will you see? Who will you meet? Who will you go with? How will you get there?



Write a poem about Australia. (Remember to include Adjectives, Adverbs, Alliteration, Onomatopoeia, Similes, Metaphors and Personification)

Research 10 facts about Australian Animals.



Research information about one of the Australian Sports. Create an information poster.

Draw/sketch a picture of a famous Australian landmark.
