By the end of Year 6, all children are expected to know all of their times tables up to and including their 12 times tables. Remember to know them you need to be able to recall them instantly. Times tables test every Thursday.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>Reading is very important. Please read some of your book at home every evening and someone should sign the reading diary. Years 5 & 6 should read every day for 25-30 minutes. These will be checked on a daily basis. Work on your fluency. How many words can you read in a minute? Expected for a Year 6 child is between 160-200 words a minute. Work on comprehension (PEE-Point, Evidence, Explanation)</p>
